Intermittent Catheterization

Chronic urinary retention leading to bladder dysfunction poses a significant challenge for affected individuals, not only due to the potential for serious complications but also because of its profound impact on their quality of life.

Intermittent Catheterization (IC) is the “gold standard” for individuals with bladder dysfunction caused by neurologic or non-neurologic causes.

What Guideline Says

Guideline recommends IC over other catheter-based options

According to the 6th International Consultation on Incontinence, IC has replaced long-term indwelling urinary catheterization for patients with neurogenic lower urinary tract dysfunction (NLUTD) resulting in incomplete bladder emptying, as it is associated with fewer urologic and non-urologic complications.

Current Association of French Urologists, European Association of Urology (EAU), American Urological Association (AUA), and the Healthcare Infection Control Practices Advisory Committee (HICPAC) guidelines recommend IC over other catheter-based options (Gamé et al, 2020; Groen, 2016, Averch, 2014, Gould, 2009).

Step5: Special Instruction for Tiemann Catheter

A special technique is required when using a Tiemann Catheter. Consult your healthcare provider for training and guidance.

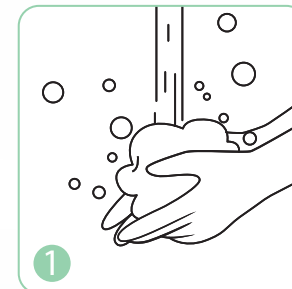
Before inserting the catheter, take note of the position of the marker on the funnel in relation to the curved tip of the catheter. This will assist you in maintaining the correct direction of the curved tip during use.

Keep the curved tip directed upwards towards the stomach during insertion and throughout the catheterization process, including withdrawal.

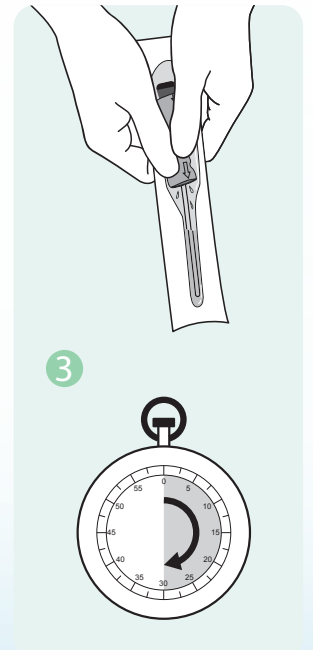

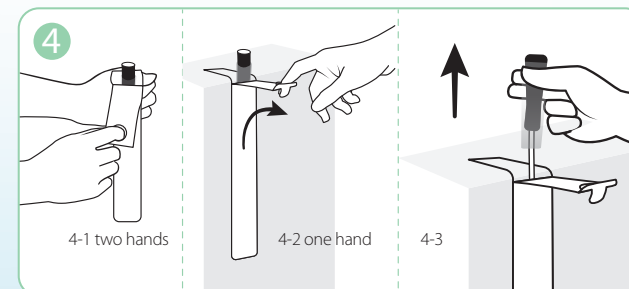
Wash hands thoroughly with soap and water.



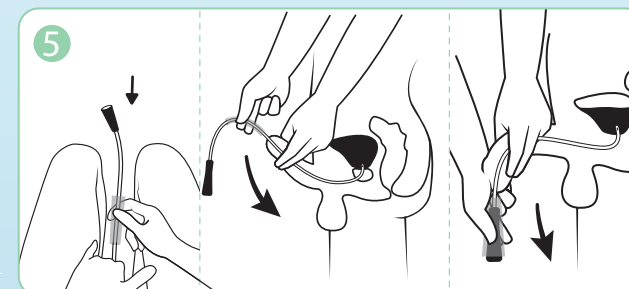
Expose and clean the urethral orifice and the surrounding skin.



ConviCath® Only.
ConviCath® Pro skips directly to step 4.
Before opening the pouch, squeeze the water sachet and let the water run down into the package. Soak the catheter for at least 30 seconds to activate the hydrophilic coating.



4-1 Tear open the catheter packaging from the tear notch until the connector is completely exposed. 4-2 Fix it to a dry surface using the adhesive tab or hang the package by its thumb grip. 4-3 Remove the catheter using the protective sleeve.



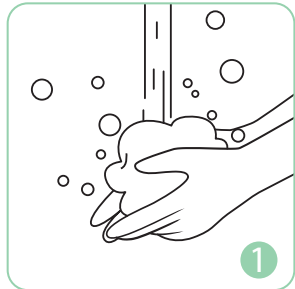
Expose the urethral opening again, and hold the catheter with the other hand, slowly insert it along the urethral opening and drain the urine into the toilet or other container.



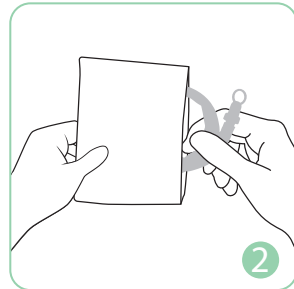
Remove the catheter and discard it. Wash your hands.

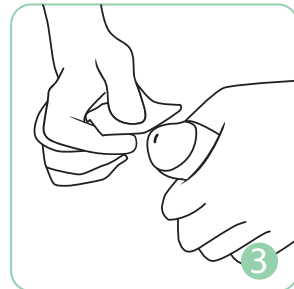

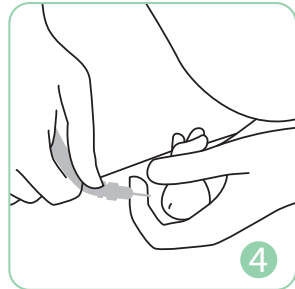
Wash your hands as advised.



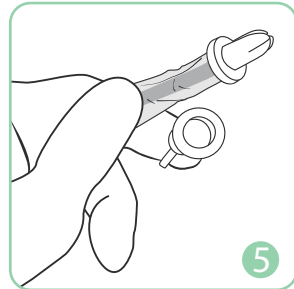
Open package and take out the catheter from package and lay it on the opened pack.



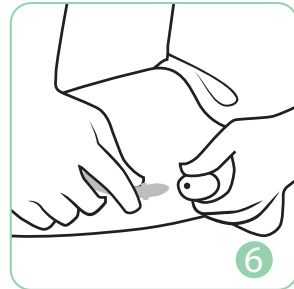
Expose the penis and hold it with your non-dominant hand until the procedure finish. Clean it and the surrounding skins.
Note: Pull back foreskin (if present).



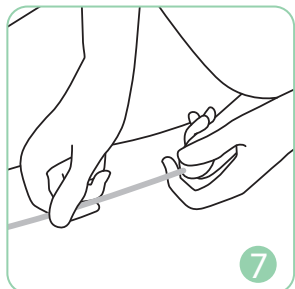
Remove the cap from the protective cover.



Hold the catheter and push it forward until the tip fills the protective cover, making sure it doesn't stick out.



Grasp catheter below protective tip plate and expose the urethral opening using your fingers and forefinger of your non-dominant hand.



With your dominant hand, insert the protective tip until the plate comes in contact with urethral opening.



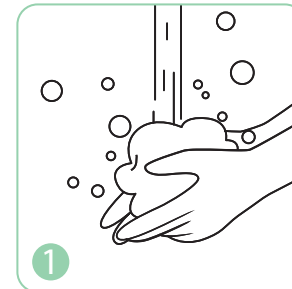
Then continuously insert the catheter until the urine starts to flow and open the sliding switch.



Removal the catheter when you're sure the bladder is empty and discard it.
DO NOT FLUSH DOWN TOILET
Wash your hands.

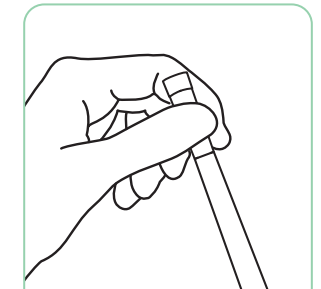

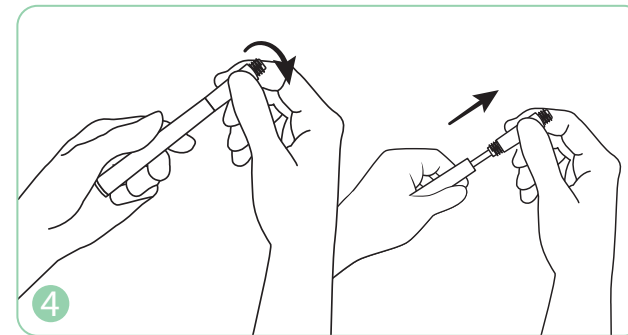
Always wash hands before use.



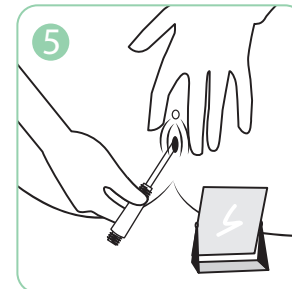
Expose and clean the urethral orifice and the surrounding skin.



Hold the product vertically, twist the cap by holding the connector.



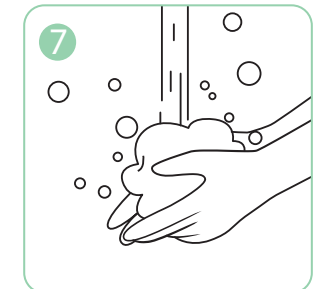
Twist the connector by holding the container, pull the catheter straight up out of the container. Empty the remaining fluid from the container (in the toilet or sink).



Insert the catheter into the urethra and drain the urine into the toilet or other container.



Dispose or carry it in your bag until disposal.



Wash your hands.
